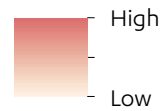
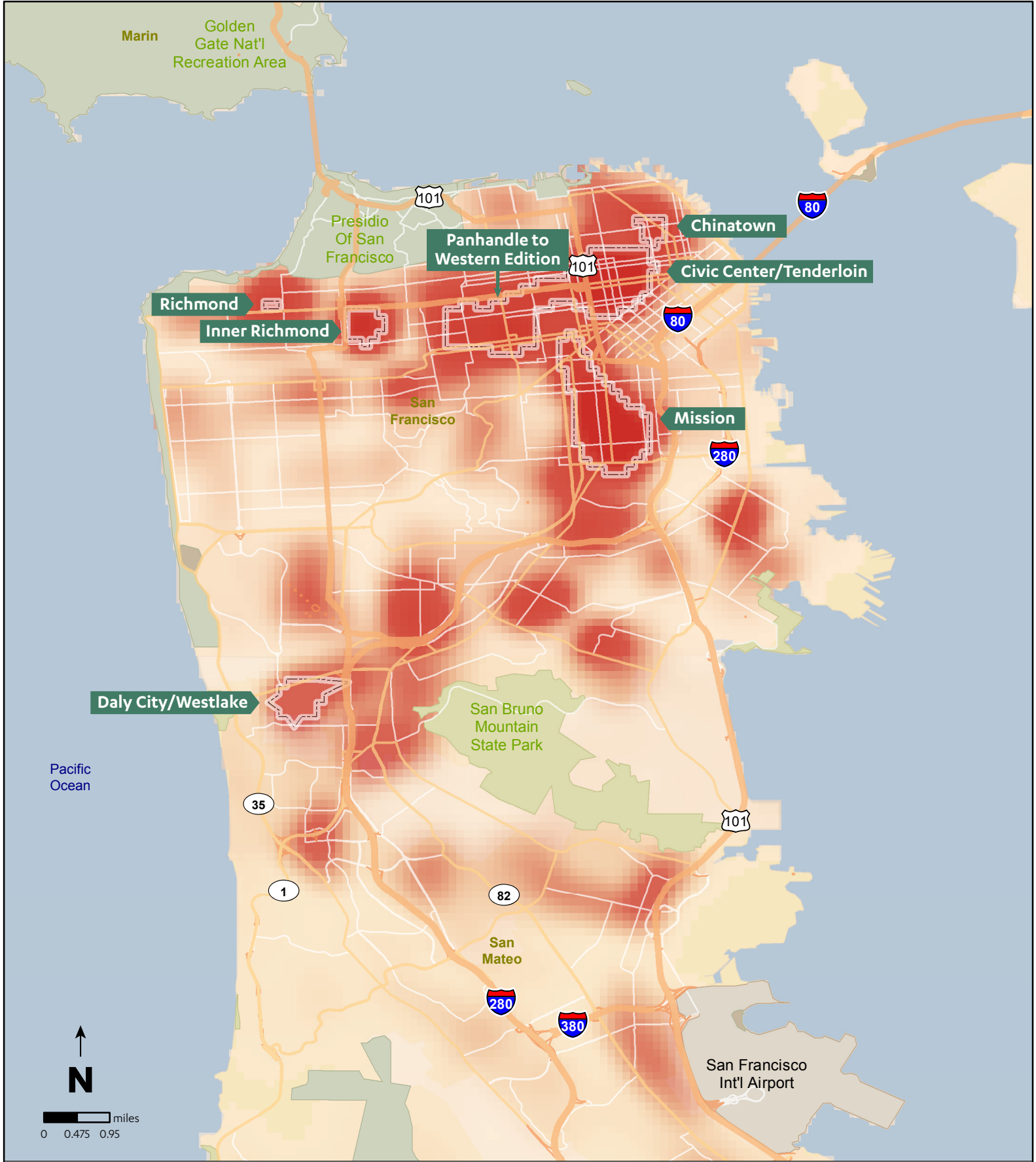


## Covered California “Hot Spots” — Bay Area

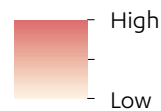


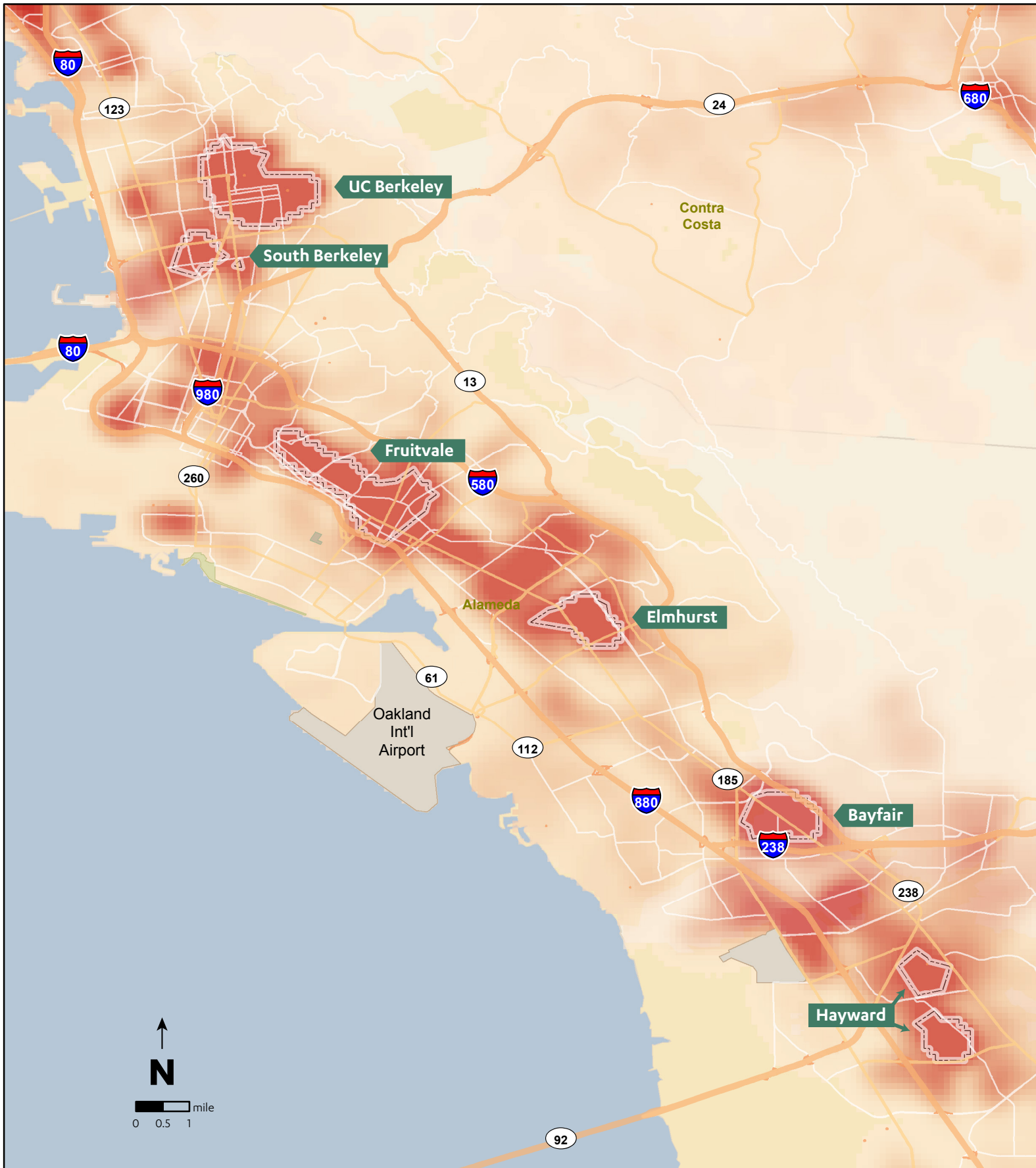


## Covered California “Hot Spots” — San Francisco

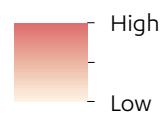


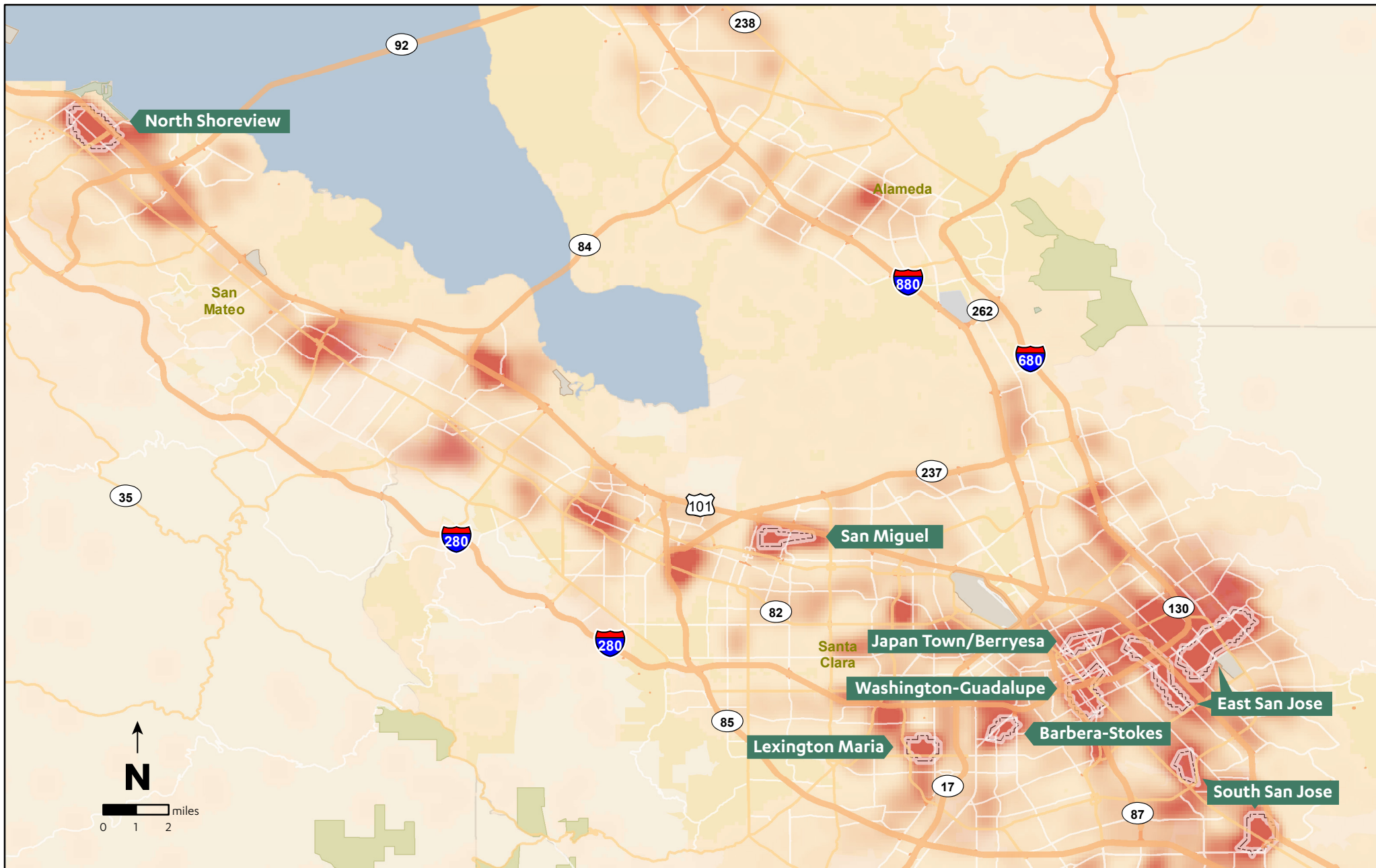


## Covered California “Hot Spots” — Oakland

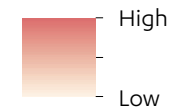


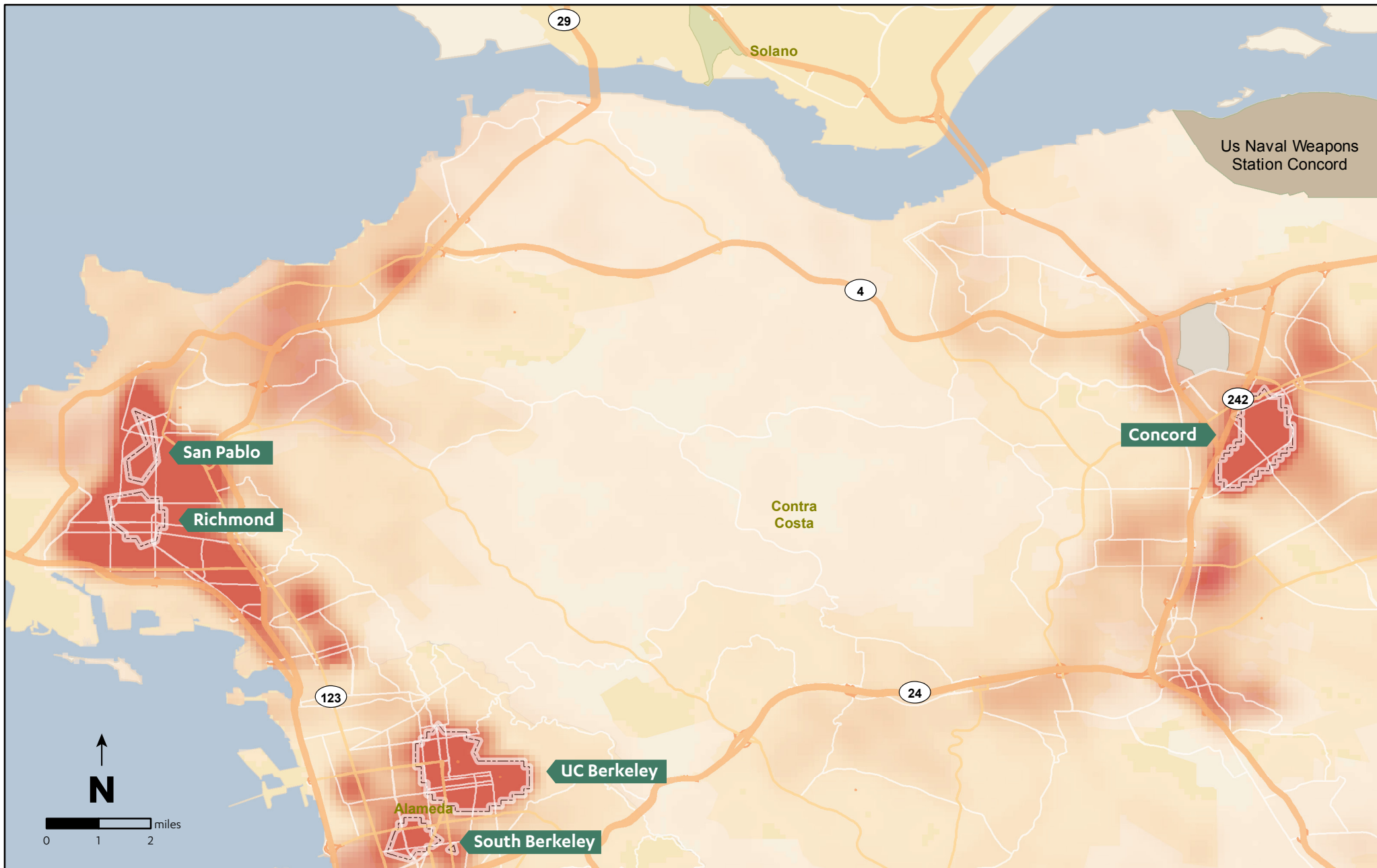


## Covered California “Hot Spots” — South Bay

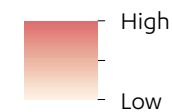




## Covered California “Hot Spots” — Contra Costa
