

# **Steps to Become a Certified Entity**

STEP

#### **Complete Application**

Entity representative will access the Certification Portal Self Registration page at: https://coveredca.force.com/Certification/s/login/SelfRegister, and

- Complete all required fields
- Create username and password
- Submit required documents, including:
  - Entity Agreement
  - Proof of:
    - Current valid license, and
    - Insurance coverage (General Liability and Workers Compensation)
  - Conflict of Interest Prevention Plan
- Submit the application!

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#### **Application Review by Covered California**

- Covered California reviews the Entity Application for eligibility and completeness (process will take from 7-10 business days), and will
- Request from the Entity applicant any missing information (if necessary).

## **Receive Approval**

Covered California sends Entity an email regarding application approval or denial based on program requirements, and

 If approved, provides additional Certification requirement instructions for the Entity to complete.

STEP

### **Complete Training**

Covered California emails instructions for Entity Primary Contact to complete required online Entity Management Training in the Learning Management System (LMS) within 90 days from registration.

Upon completion of all registration requirements, the Certified Entity may complete their enrollment counselor roster and prepare to enroll consumers in affordable health care insurance.
